

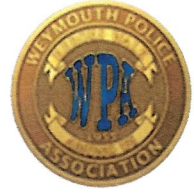

On behalf of Tiny Transplant Titans and the Squillante Family, the Weymouth Firefighters Local 1616 and the Weymouth Police Association would like to extend our sincere appreciation and gratitude for your support of this year's 6th Annual Weymouth Winter Classic Charity Hockey Game. Our event was a tremendous success because of your amazing generosity, with a great crowd in attendance and raising over \$24,000 for Tiny Transplant Titans in honor of Steve Squillante 3rd.

Little Steve was born in October 2021 with a rare liver disorder called Biliary Atresia that required immediate lifesaving surgery and placement on the pediatric transplant list. While awaiting his transplant, Steve and his parents quarantined in their home to avoid illness for over a year. During testing to see if they were potential donors, doctors also discovered Steve's father had an early form of blood cancer. Fortunately, Steve's mother Shannon was a match to be a living donor and little Steve received his lifesaving gift of a liver transplant in August of 2023. Steve and both of his parents are now on the road to recovery.

Steve's parents formed Tiny Transplant Titans as a registered 501(c)3 charity to assist other families who are also awaiting a lifesaving pediatric transplant. With the money raised through our charity hockey game and your generosity, the Squillante Family and Tiny Transplant Titans will be able to provide care packages with basic necessities to over 200 families on the pediatric transplant floor at Boston Children's Hospital! We are continually amazed by the strength, compassion, and support of our community.

It was another exciting evening of hockey, camaraderie, family, friends, and community spirit. We have already begun planning for next year's game, and we hope you will once again consider being a part of it.
